If you registered within 2 (two) weeks of the starting date of this workshop, books will NOT be shipped to the address you provided when you registered. You will receive your books at the workshop site. (See either workshop speaker or the coordinator at the workshop site to pick-up your books).

### **EXAM**

The Exam is optional, but it is considered to be an important part of the seminar and all participants are strongly recommended to take it. Prior to attending the seminar you are encouraged to attempt the sample exams contained in these papers and this should be done under exam conditions i.e. adhering to the time limits laid down and the restrictions on reference materials.

The exam lasts 3 hours and consists of two parts, which are divided into two sections respectively. Part I of the Exam should take no more than 55 minutes and no reference materials are permitted. Examinees are allowed to commence Part II of the exam when they have returned their Part I papers. Reference materials such as the Rule book and Decisions book are allowed in Part II, which lasts the balance of the 3 hours (i.e. if you take 40 minutes on Part 1, you have 2 hours and 20 minutes for Part II). **It is not permissible to use a computer, tablet, mobile phone or camera during the exam but the use of a dictionary is permitted.**

Questions in the exam are based on: Definitions Section of the Rule book, Rules 1 to 34 and the related Decisions, and Appendix IV. Please note that the Exam does not include any questions on Appendices I, II, or III.
