

Golf Pass Program

Terms and Conditions

January 30th, 2017

This game is intended for play in Newfoundland and Labrador only and is limited to individuals who are members of a participating golf course or hold a current Golf Newfoundland Labrador/Golf Canada Public Player Membership Card.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY.

1. HOW IT WORKS: The promotion begins May 29th, 2017 and runs until October 6th, 2017 at 11:59 PM Newfoundland Standard Time (the "Contest Period").

Beginning on May 28th, 2017 contestants can use a Passport Card (ballot) obtained from their member course or, for Public Players, the offices of GNL. Normally the Passport Card would be distributed to members prior to the start of the contest. A list of the participating Golf Newfoundland Labrador member courses can be seen at <http://www.golfnl.ca>. Limit of 3,500 Passport Cards (ballots) are available.

Each Passport Card (ballot) contains a list of all participating member courses and is grouped into five regions. The regions include: Labrador, Western, Central, Eastern and Avalon. A Passport Card will be converted into a ballot when an individual either:

1. Plays one (1) round in each of the five (5) regions or,
2. Plays a total of seven (7) rounds in three (3) different regions

Each time an individual plays a different course they can request to have their Passport Card (ballot) stamped with a special GNL/Member stamp in the appropriate course and region. The Passport Card becomes a ballot when an individual has played a number of rounds in the desired regions. The ballot would be completed with name, e-mail address with Home Course Name and then submitted to their respective course of origin.

Entries are limited to: one ballot per person.

3,500 Passport Cards printed. Contest open while supplies last. Last day to receive a Passport Card (ballot) is August 30th, 2017. Participating courses and GNL will stop accepting ballots at 11:59 PM, NST October 6th, 2017.

3. Grand Prize

On October 31st, 2017, at 11:00 AM a grand prize winner will be drawn from all valid ballots received throughout the contest period up to 11:59 PM NST on October 6th, 2017.

The first name drawn will be the winner of the grand prize,

Grand Prize Package includes: Airfare for two from St. John's to the host city of the 2018 RBC Canadian Open, tickets for two to attend the RBC Canadian Open, and three nights' accommodations for two.

The contest prize award will start and end in St. John's, NL with the winner and guest traveling to and from St. John's (at their own cost) if they live outside the area.
